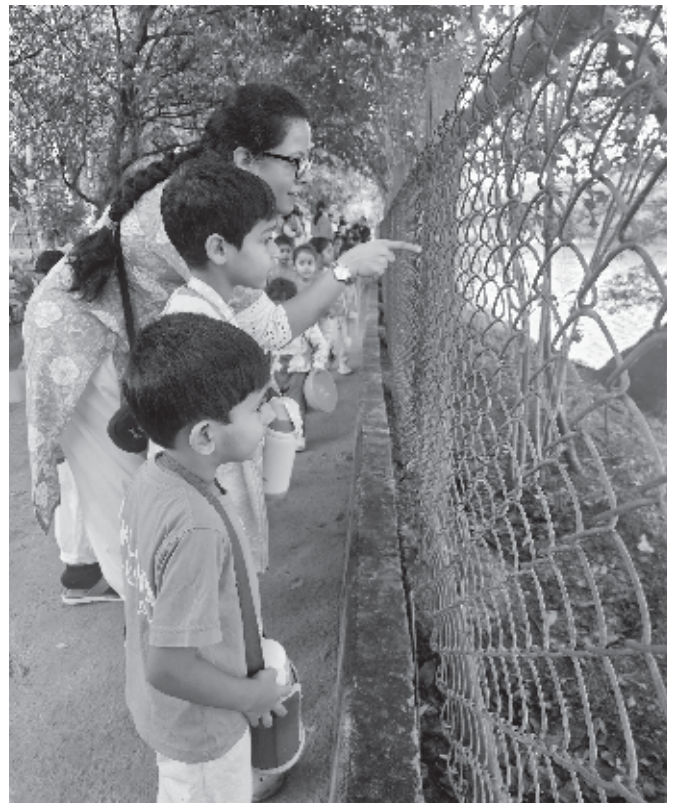
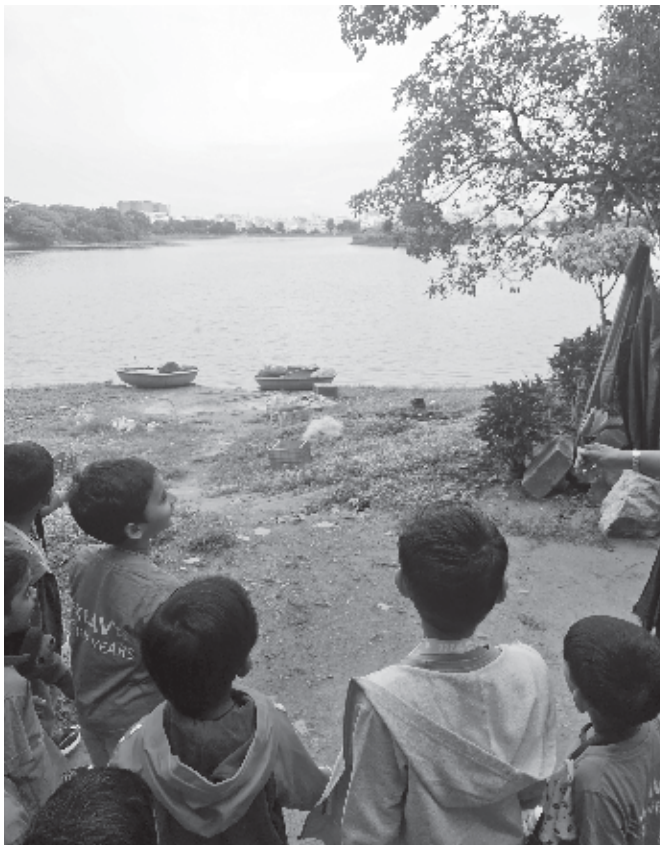

### Field Visits

**10 Oct: FV to Kogilu Lake** - Children visited Kogilu Lake this month. They were thrilled to see the fishermen's boats and nets as well as the lakeside's large and sprawling trees. They collected beautiful leaves and flowers which had fallen on the ground and observed the different shapes of the leaves. Children also spotted a beautiful kingfisher perched on a branch and were mesmerised by the lilies growing in the lake.





**31 Oct: FV to Decathlon -** Children visited Decathlon this month to learn about various sports and sports equipment available today. They were very curious to learn about equipment like skateboards, frisbees, camping tents, etc. Children enjoyed the different demonstrations of the equipment done by the store personnel as well.



## Events and Celebrations

**Diwali Celebration:** In celebration of Diwali, the children prepared their own rangoli powder and made wonderful rangolis with it. They also created beautifully painted clay diyas. The hands-on process brought them great joy and a strong sense of accomplishment. They also participated enthusiastically in cleaning their classroom - carefully dusting shelves and returning each material to its proper place.





## Curriculum

**Practical Life Skills: Brushing Teeth** - PG practiced brushing teeth this month. They were so thrilled to be learning how to do so in school and were keen to stand in front of the mirror and watch themselves as they brushed their teeth.



**FMS: Transferring water from bowl to bowl** - PG children practiced transferring water bowl to bowl this month. This activity requires incredible patience, concentration and balance. Children were very careful while doing this activity and spilt only minimal quantities of water.



**FMS: Crumpling paper and painting with it -** TG children learnt how to crumple newspaper with their hands this month. This is a great fine motor muscle strengthening activity and requires a lot of strength and effort from them. After they learnt how to crumple the newspaper, they enjoyed painting with the crumpled ball.



**Art: Painting Giraffes -** Children painted the large metal giraffes in our school recently. They used rollers to apply enamel paint beautifully on the giraffes. The children were careful with their bodies and their clothing as they knew enamel paint is not like poster paints which washes off easily with water. They showed tremendous meticulousness, patience and dexterity while painting the giraffes. It was a pleasure to have our children create a mural artwork for our school.



**Art: Finger Printing** - Kg children enjoyed doing finger printing this month. Children love painting with their fingers and are gradually learning how restrain themselves and to print with their finger instead of using it as a brush to paint.



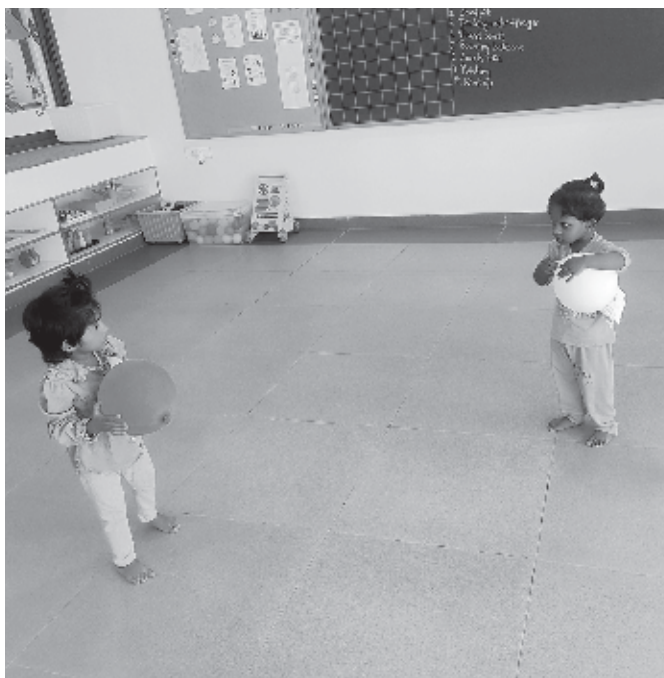

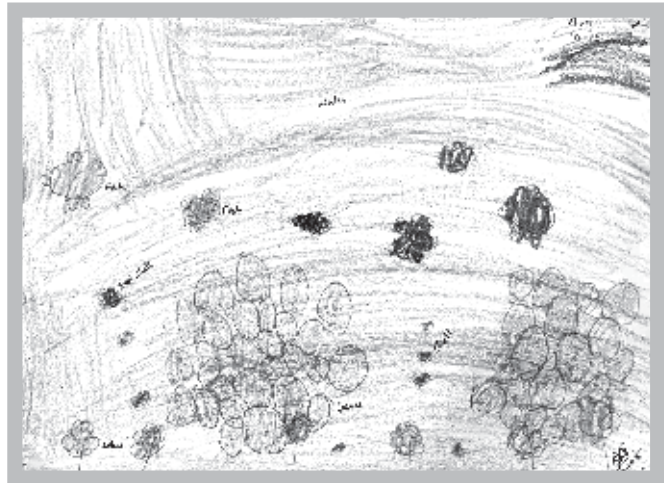
